Salelologa Power Station, Savaii, Samoa

July 2014 – December 2014

This ground mounted system is located on Savaii, which is the largest island in Samoa.

It is made up of the following components:

- 552 x Trina 260W Solar Modules
- 1 x SMA STP12000-TL inverter
- 7 x SMA STP17000-TL inverters
- 1 x ETE 150kVA 3Ph Transformer



Once the ground works were complete at the Racecourse Solar Farm we relocated our Samoan team to Salelologa and they laid the concrete pads and set up the array frames – getting the site ready for our solar team to install the system.

The Salelologa system was completed and commissioned just before Christmas 2014.
